Terms and Conditions of Entry

The promoter of this competition is Word Up North.

1. The competition is open to children aged 12 and under, who are residents of the United Kingdom, except for children of employees of the promoters or anyone else professionally connected with this competition. Entrants must have the permission of a parent or guardian to enter.
2. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
3. The competition opens at 9am on Friday 25 September 2026. The closing date is 4pm on 18 October 2026. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
4. Entries must include entrant's name, age, and the name, telephone number and email of the entrant's consenting parent or guardian. Entry forms can be collected from The Grove Bookshop or downloaded online via <https://www.ilkleyliteraturefestival.org.uk/>
5. Competition entrant and consenting parent/guardian agrees to the use of the entrant's name in any publicity material. Any personal data relating to the winners, or any other entrants, will be used solely in accordance with current UK data protection legislation. Data will not be disclosed to any other third party without the entrant's prior consent.
